About Project and Objectives:

With this project we want to show to the participants how to live among other Europeans citizen while respecting the sustainability in terms of the environment and economy. By placing such a subject in the center of attention, it aims to promote intercultural dialogue, stimulate a creative and innovative mindset in young people and encouraging them in the commitment to active European citizenship

This project has the following objectives:

1. Teach participants the concepts of sustainable development through non-formal education.
2. Allowing young people to discuss their views on this issue and to compare practices adopted by their country.
3. Promote the learning of foreign languages, especially English and French.
4. Confront the young participants to cultural differences.
5. Promote youth engagement in active European citizenship.

Activities:

We will implemente the project through workshops for youth, using non-formal & informal learning methods like:

- Working groups and reflection.
- Workshops for get to know better participants and they experience (discussion learning method).
- Cultural visits.
- Role playing, presentation games and other consolidation activities.
- Intercultural evenings (every evening one culture group will introduce their culture difference).

For who is it?

Participants are expected to fall under the following criteria:

- Totally 5 people from each country
- age of **18 – 25** Years old
- Able to work in simple English
- Highly motivated and willing to actively participate during the whole project.

Financials

- Food, board and the exchange activities are covered by the EU Programme for education, training, youth and sport **Erasmus+**.
- Regarding travel costs, participants pay the travel tickets and after the project there will be reimbursement. There is a fixed amount to be reimbursed for each country which is for both arrival and departure. For Macedonia maximum reimbursement per person is **170 Euro**.
